Terms & Conditions:

- Scholarships shall be awarded for one academic year.
- Scholarships shall be awarded to the students whose parents' gross income not exceed Rs. 8.00 lakhs per annum.
- Income Tax Return forms of the last three years of the parents should accompany with application. In case where parents are self employed or not filing the IT returns then the Income certificate issued by the revenue official shall only be considered.
- The parents shall be required to submit an affidavit of their immovable property.
- Girl students coming from families having no male child will be given preference. Supporting documents such as an affidavit of parents duly attested by notary is required.
- The committee member(s) may visit the home(s) of the students and shall monitor the performance of students to whom merit-cum-means scholarship shall be awarded.
- A student registered/admitted during the academic year 2015-16 should obtain a CGPA of at least 6.00 for continuing the scholarship. The student admitted in 2016-17 onward should obtain a CGPA of at least 7.00 for continuing the scholarship. The student should not have back log in the year of consideration. The income criterion should also be satisfied for the continuation.
- The information provided by the applicant for availing the merit-cum-mans scholarship can be verified by the committee at any point of time. If any information found false, scholarship will be withdrawn and disciplinary action will be taken against the student.
- The right of awarding the merit-cum-means scholarship shall lie with the award committee.
