

Credit-Transfer Program between Thapar University and Trinity College Dublin

Thapar University has undergone an academic agreement with Trinity College Dublin, Ireland. This agreement will give students admitted to the undergraduate engineering programs at Thapar University (TU) an opportunity to study in the year 3 and 4 at Ireland's leading university, Trinity College Dublin.

Further in this agreement the students who are presently in second year may also go to Trinity College Dublin subject to meeting the following academic requirements:

1. Students after the completion of second year should have a minimum CGPA of 8.5.
2. There should be no backlog.

Transfer of the present third year students is a scholarship program in which 50% of the Tuition Fee of Trinity College Dublin will be borne by Thapar University. Trinity will also support part of tuition fee which is currently being discussed, in addition to TU's contribution. This amount will be announced soon.

Present third year Students, who are interested in pursuing their 3rd and 4th year in Trinity College Dublin and are eligible as per the above mentioned academic requirements can apply on the prescribed application form available w.e.f April 28 , 2015 from the office of Dean, Academic Affairs. These application forms may be submitted to the office of Dean, Academic Affairs by May 11, 2015.
