**Subject: Submission of online application forms under Post Matric Scholarship to SC and OBC students for the year 2014-15.**

Please refer to our notice No. TI/DA/PMS/SC/ dated July 28, 2014, August 21, 2014 and September 19, 2013 regarding submission of **on line for POST MATRIC SCHOLARSHIP for SC and OBC** students whose **family income is less than Rs. 2,50,000/- P.A (for SC students) and Rs. 1,00,000/- (for OBC students) respectively**. Eligible students are advised to visit site [www.punjabscholarships.gov.in](http://www.punjabscholarships.gov.in) and fill up the application forms after getting themselves registered. **The last date of submission the application forms on web portal is extended upto 07.11.2014** and other guideline are mentioned on the [www.punjabscholarships.gov.in](http://www.punjabscholarships.gov.in). Students are advised to submit the print out of application form alongwith following documents in the **office of Dean, Student Affairs (Room no.L-106) at the earliest so that applications may be forwarded in time** on any working day during students hour i.e. 3.30.PM to 4.30 PM.

**An application for POST MATRIC SCHOLARSHIP should comprise:**

1. A Certificate (in original) of Caste duly signed by an authorized Revenue Officer not below the rank of Tehsildar for fresher and attested copy for renewal case.
2. A Residence certificate (in original) duly signed by an authorized Revenue Officer not below the rank of Tehsildar for fresher and attested copy for renewal case.
3. An income certificate duly signed by an authorized Revenue Officer not below the rank of Tehsildar. A self declaration by the self-employed parents/guardians, stating definite income from all sources by way of an affidavit on non-judicial stamp paper. Employed parents/guardians are required to obtain income certificate from their employer and for any additional income, from other sources, they would furnish declaration by way of an affidavit on non-judicial stamp paper.
4. One attested copy of certificates, Diploma, Degree etc. in respect of all examination passed
5. One copy of the passport size photograph of the student thereon.



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
