- 4. The programmes have been granted provisional accreditation. Thapar University, Thapar Technology Campus, Post Box No. 32, Bhadson Road, Patiala- 147004, Punjab should submit the Compliance Report at least six months before the expiry of validity of accreditation mentioned above to be eligible to be considered by the concerned Committee in NBA for further processing of the accreditation status. This could entail further extension of accreditation or a revisit, as deemed appropriate by NBA Committees.

The accreditation status awarded to the programmes as indicated in the above table does not imply that the accreditation has been granted to Thapar University, Thapar Technology Campus, Post Box No. 32, Bhadson Road, Patiala- 147004, Punjab as a whole. As such the Institution should nowhere along with its name including on its letter head etc. write that it is accredited by NBA because it is programmes accreditation and not institution accreditation. If such an instance comes to NBA's notice, this will be viewed seriously. Complete name of the programmes accredited level of programmes and the period of validity of accreditation, as well as the Academic Year from which the accreditation is effective should be mentioned unambiguously whenever and wherever it is required to indicate the status of accreditation by NBA.
- 6. The accreditation status of the above programmes is subject to change on periodic review, if needed by the NBA. It is desired that the relevant information in respect of accredited programmes as indicated in the table in paragraph 2, appears on the website and information bulletin of the Institute.
