

7. M.A. PROGRAMME and POST GRADUATE DIPLOMA (PROFESSIONAL)

7.1 M.A. (Psychology)

Thapar Institute of Engineering & Technology offers M.A. (Psychology) programme of 2-years duration (4 Semesters)

I. Eligibility for M.A. (Psychology)

Recognized Bachelor degree in Psychology (Honors) or Arts/ Science/ Allied Sciences such as Home Sciences/Nursing/Human Development/ B.Tech of minimum 3-years duration with 50% marks (45% for SC/ST) in aggregate and Psychology as one of the subjects at graduation level. Candidates who have appeared in the examination of the final year shall also be eligible. However, for such candidates, admission shall be provisional.

The program shall have following two specializations:

- Clinical Psychology
- Counseling Psychology

II. No. of seats in M.A. (Psychology) program: 20 (SC/ST-5, PH-1)

III. Mode of Selection:

The merit list for admissions to MA (Psychology) programme shall be made by combining percentage of marks obtained at 12th and Graduation (aggregate marks upto end of second year/four semesters will be considered). Graduation must be done from a recognized University.

Candidate must attach mark sheets of 12th and all the marks sheets of Graduation upto end of 2nd year along with the printout of applications.

Candidates having any pending backlog in the first two years of Graduation shall not be considered for admission. Percentage of marks secured at the end of 2nd year of graduation shall only be considered even if the candidate has completed the graduation.

5% additional marks will be added for the students having honors degree in Psychology.

7.2 Post Graduate Diploma (Professional) In Clinical and Counseling Psychology

Thapar Institute of Engineering & Technology offers Post Graduate Diploma (Professional) In Clinical and Counseling Psychology programme of 1-year duration (2 Semesters)

I. Eligibility

M.A/MSc in Psychology. Candidates having M.A. in Psychology with specialization in Counseling & Clinical Psychology will be given first preference for admission. Candidates must have 55% marks (50% for SC/ST) in aggregate at Masters and Graduation Level. Those who have appeared in the examination of the Masters final year shall also be eligible to apply. However, for such candidates admission shall be provisional.

II. No. of seats 20 (SC/ST-5, PH-1)

III. Mode of Selection:

The admission will be based on the marks obtained in B.A./ B.Sc and M.A Psychology. For provisional admission, marks available up to pre-final year of M.A/ M.Sc shall be considered.

Candidate must attach all the marks sheets of Graduation and of Masters up to pre-final year along with the printout of applications.

Candidates having any pending backlog in the Masters level shall not be considered for admission. Percentage of marks secured at the end of pre-final year of Masters shall only be considered even if the candidate has completed the Masters.
