NOTICE FOR BRANCH UPGRADATION AFTER COMPLETION OF 1ST YEAR IN UG PROGRAMS (AFTER SUCCESSFUL COMPLETION OF FIRST TWO SEMESTERS OF SESSION 2023-24)

The applications are invited from UG students admitted in TIET in session 2023-24 for **branch upgradation after completion of 1**st **year (First Two Semesters at TIET)**. The eligibility criteria to apply for this upgradation is described as under:

Student should have:

- 1. completed all the course credits prescribed in the first two semesters;
- 2. no backlog at the end of first year of 4-year BE Degree programs;
- 3. secured a minimum of Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA)
 - a. \geq 7.00 for SC, ST and PH category students
 - b. ≥ 8.50 for General category and other category students

OR

- 1. The student on the basis of his/her category, was eligible for admission to a certain branch (in which he/she wants to upgrade/change now), at the time of entry to TIET Patiala on the basis of his/her JEE (Mains) 2023 score/PCM score.
- 2. no backlog at the end of first year of 4-year BE Degree programs;

The applications completed in all respects should reach Academic Section or alternatively filled applications can be sent online to acad8@thapar.edu through email on or before July 02, 2024.

Counselling for upgradation will be held tentatively on **July 10, 2024** (11:00 am) through Zoom meeting. Instructions regarding the same shall be communicated to the applicants through email.

NOTE:

- 1. A student will be permitted to change from branch A to branch B against the vacant seats (if any) in branch B, strictly on the basis of merit of CGPA obtained during first year of study here, if strength of does 90% sanctioned branch Α not fall below of its strength (equivalently at most 10% students of sanctioned strength of a branch are permitted to leave it). The request of the student will be reconsidered again, strictly in CGPA order, if she/he does not violate this rule due to another student getting transferred to branch A.
- 2. Applications from TIET students who satisfy the eligibility criteria are to be considered in the order as given below.
 - a. All students who satisfy the norms with CGPA more than 8.50 (7.0 for SC/ST/PH) are allocated first
 - b. Students who were eligible for admission to branch B at the time of entry to TIET Patiala are allocated subsequently.
- 3. Branch upgradation after completion of 1st year on the basis of merit of CGPA is only for the students who have completed first two semesters at TIET.

- 4. Students admitted in International Engineering program shall not be allowed to appear in Branch Upgradation process at the end of First Year.
- 5. Students who got upgradation, will have to clear the courses relevant to his/her new stream. They will have to pay the requisite fee as notified by DoAA to clear such courses.
- 6. Students of branches such as Biotechnology/Biomedical Engg./ Computer Science and Business Systems where the course scheme is significantly different from the course scheme of other branches, shall not be allowed to appear in this branch upgradation process.
